

How to seal a network server rack

Sealing a network server rack involves closing all open U spaces, side gaps, and cable openings to optimize airflow, reduce hotspots, and improve cooling efficiency. Key Areas to Seal

- Open U Spaces:** Unused rack units (U spaces) should be sealed with blanking panels to prevent cool air from bypassing equipment. Ensure panels fit tightly, as even a 1/16" gap can leave significant open area, reducing cooling efficiency and creating hotspots. Full-rack blanking solutions are available for racks that are partially populated or empty, providing a complete seal along the vertical plane of IT equipment intakes.
- Side Gaps Between Rails and Cabinet Walls:** Many racks have open spaces between the equipment rails and the cabinet sides. These gaps allow hot air to recirculate to the front or conditioned air to escape. Use side air seals or rail gap covers to block these openings, ensuring airflow passes through the equipment rather than around it.
- Cable Openings and Top/Bottom Gaps:** Air can escape through cable entry points at the top or bottom of the rack. Brush strips, grommets, or filler panels can seal these areas while allowing cables to pass through. Additionally, sealing the top and bottom of the rack prevents unwanted air mixing and maintains consistent airflow patterns.

- Air-Seal Kits:** Pre-fabricated kits cover front sides, top, and unused mounting areas. Tool-less designs allow quick installation and removal, and some kits are customizable in metal or color to fit specific racks.
- Expanding Foam or Sealing Tape:** Products like Cool Shield AirStrip or Acrycell Sealing Tape can fill irregular gaps around racks, under cabinets, or in raised flooring to prevent bypass airflow and hot air recirculation.

- Check for Complete Coverage:** Ensure all blanking panels and seals are flush with the rack to avoid small gaps.
- Prioritize High-Impact Areas:** Focus on open U spaces and side gaps first, as these contribute most to airflow inefficiency.
- Regular Maintenance:** Inspect seals periodically, especially after adding or removing equipment, to maintain opti...
