Liquid-tight cable glands should be used for all incoming and outgoing conduits to maintain the enclosure's integrity.

Ensure the box is level and firmly attached to prevent tampering or accidental dislodging. Pre-molded knockout holes can be used for cable entry, and ventilation breathers can help prevent condensation inside the box.
