

How to switch a fiber optic cable

Some temporary service interruptions may occur during this process. For multi-unit buildings, the process may differ slightly, and additional planning may be required.

Step 5: Activation and Optimization After installation, your provider will activate your fiber service. You may need to plug in your modem and configure your network. Test your connection to ensure optimal speeds and performance. Providers often offer guidance for troubleshooting or optimizing your new fiber connection.
