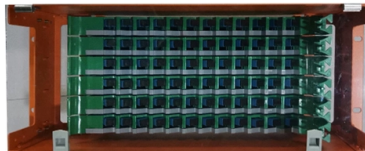


How to use a PoE optical port switch

To use the optical port of a PoE switch, insert an SFP module into the port, connect a compatible fiber optic cable, and ensure proper alignment with the receiving device or switch.

- 1. Check Compatibility** Ensure your PoE switch has an SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) slot. - 4. Connect the Other End** If connecting to another PoE switch with an SFP slot, repeat the same steps on the second switch. If the other device lacks an SFP port, use a PoE media converter to convert the optical signal back to Ethernet, then connect via RJ45 cable.
- 5. Power and Verify** Power on the switch and check the port indicators. A solid or flashing LINK/ACT light indicates successful data transmission. Ensure the PoE devices connected downstream are receiving power normally.

Additional Tips

- Distance and Cable Type:** Use multi-mode fiber for short distances (up to 550 meters) and single-mode fiber for longer runs (up to several kilometers).
- Media Converters:** Required when one side does not have an SFP slot. Both sides need a converter if neither device supports SFP.
- Handling Fiber:** Avoid sharp bends and excessive pulling to prevent damage. Use proper conduit if burying fiber outdoors.
- SFP Module Selection:** Match the module type (speed, duplex, and wavelength) to your network requirements.
