

How to use a fiber optic patch cord stripper

Tips and Precautions

- Take small sections at a time: Strip in increments (e.g., 6–8mm) to avoid stressing the fiber ().
- Angle the stripper correctly: Hold the fiber at a slight angle (around 45°) to reduce stress and prevent breakage ().
- Avoid overheating: Excessive heat can damage the fiber; start low and increase gradually if needed ().
- Clean the device: Remove debris from the fiber holder and heating area after each use ().
- Safety: The thermal stripper gets hot; handle with care to avoid burns ().

By following these steps, you can efficiently strip fiber optic patch cords with minimal risk of breakage, preparing them for splicing or connectorization.
