Insert the fiber cable into the corresponding transmit (TX) and receive (RX) ports, ensuring proper alignment. If using SFP modules, insert the module into the switch first, then connect the fiber cable to the module. Configure Your Network If connecting to an ISP, ensure your optical endpoint is compatible with the network protocol. For example, GPON networks require GPON-compatible ONUs, not standard fiber-to-Ethernet converters. Configure your switch or connected devices for PPPoE or other authentication methods if required by your ISP.
