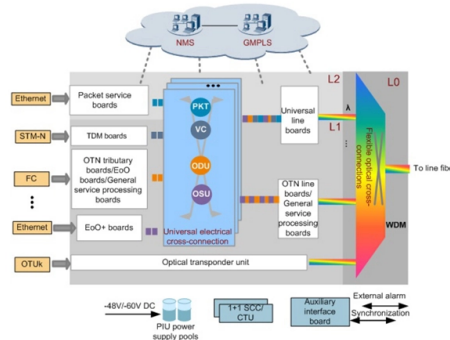


How to wire the ground wire of the monitoring distribution box

Connection Method: Strip the wire to the appropriate length, attach it securely to the PE bar or grounding stud, and tighten screws or bolts to ensure a firm connection. For stainless steel enclosures, remove oxide layers or coatings at contact points to reduce resistance and prevent corrosion. Flexible copper braided tape can be used for moving parts like hinged doors.

Metal Enclosure Bonding: The metal box itself must be connected to the PE bus using a copper wire or braided soft wire. Any metal conduits or threaded pipes connected to the box should also be electrically bonded to maintain continuity.

Resistance Requirements: The total grounding resistance should be very low to ensure safety. For industrial applications, the resistance between system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm, and all connections should be tested to confirm compliance.

Internal Component Grounding: Any electrical components inside the distribution box that require grounding must be connected to the PE bar using copper wires. Clearly mark all grounding connections...

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
