When selecting switches for stacking, ensure: The switch model supports stacking (e.g., S5735-S-V2, S5700, S6700 series) Stack ports are available and compatible with certified stack cables (e.g., QSFP-40G-Stack for CSS) Firmware versions are uniform across all stack members Configuration Best Practices Pre-Stacking Preparation: Verify stack support, check stack port availability, and confirm firmware versions. Physical Connection: Connect stack ports using certified optical or dedicated stack cables. For redundancy, a ring topology is recommended over a simple chain to avoid single points of failure. Logical Configuration: Assign member IDs and priorities before connecting stack cables. Configure physical stack ports in system view and ensure they are not used for ordinary service traffic. Synchronization: Enable auto-upgrade to synchronize firmw...
