

Inductor installation location in distribution box

- 1. If unavoidable, use inductors with a closed magnetic circuit to minimize leakage.
- 3. Maintain Terminal Spacing** Ensure sufficient distance between inductor terminals. Short spacing can create stray capacitance, which may induce high-frequency signals into adjacent circuits ().
- 4. Thermal Considerations** Inductors generate heat during operation. Install them in areas with adequate airflow and avoid placing them near heat-sensitive components. Copper areas around the inductor should be optimized for heat dissipation but not excessively large to prevent EMI issues ().
- 5. Distribution Box Layout** Inside a distribution box, mount the inductor on a DIN rail or secure platform, ensuring it is accessible for inspection and maintenance. Keep it away from moisture-prone areas and maintain proper insulation from other live components ().
- 6. Wiring Practices** Use short, direct connections to the inductor to minimize parasitic inductance. Avoid routing signal wires directly under or near the inductor. Label connections clearly and maintain neat cable management to prevent accidental sho...
