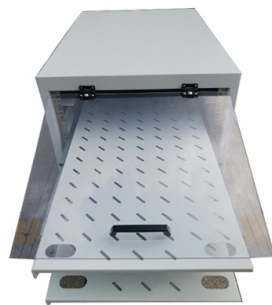

- Biological Growth:** Accumulation of biofilm or algae inside the box can restrict wastewater flow.

- Slow-draining toilets, sinks, or showers throughout the house
- Pooling water or wet spots in the yard, especially near the drainfield
- Spongy or unusually green grass patches over the drainfield
- Gurgling sounds in plumbing
- Foul odors near the septic system

- Remove the Blockage:** Use a small trowel, scoop, or plumbing snake to clear solids. For stubborn clogs, a high-pressure sewer jetter may be used to flush the lateral lines.
