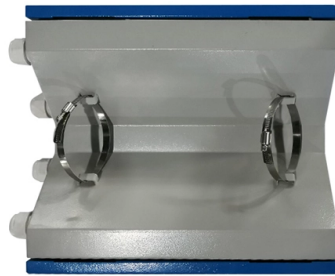

Annual or biennial comprehensive maintenance should include partial disassembly, testing of internal components, and verification of grounding and lightning protection systems.

Preventive testing before high-temperature seasons helps identify equipment at risk of overheating or failure.

Maintenance Procedures Clean components using manufacturer-recommended methods, avoiding abrasive materials or harsh chemicals. Replace damaged or worn seals, gaskets, and wiring promptly to maintain explosion-proof integrity.
