Arc isolation plates are installed to separate high-voltage line-side components from low-voltage or accessible areas, minimizing the risk of arc flash and protecting personnel. Purpose of Arc Isolation Plates Arc isolation plates, also known as partition walls or barriers, are designed to segregate high-voltage conductors from low-voltage equipment and accessible areas within distribution boxes or switchgear. This separation reduces the likelihood of accidental contact, foreign object intrusion, and arc flash incidents, while allowing maintenance personnel to work safely on low-voltage components without full PPE exposure (Rittal, Schneider Electric) . Placement and Configuration Line-Side Isolation: Plates should be installed between the incoming high-voltage conductors and the rest of the distribution panel. This ensures that any arc originating on the line side is contained within a dedicated compartment (ArcBlok) . Modular Panels: For modular distribution boxes, limit plates or partition walls are typically required between each module or door. For example, in Siemens modular cubicles, n-1 limit plates are needed for n modular doors to maintain proper isolation . Customizable Layouts: Many enclosures allow flexible combinations of high- and low-voltage compartments. Isolation plates can be adjusted or added to suit specific equipment layouts while maintaining compliance with safety standards (NFPA 70E) . Installation Guidelines Secure Mounting: Attach the isolation plate firmly to the enclosure frame using the manufacturer's recommended mounting hardware to prevent movement during operation. Full Coverage: Ensure the plate extends across the full height and width of the compartment to prevent gaps where arcs could propagate. Accessibility Considerations: Incorporate access points, such as fold-down shelves or interface flaps, for monitoring and maintenance without exposing person...
