Wiring and Electrical Connections Power must be turned off during installation to ensure safety. Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load current. Ensure neat cable management, proper insulation, and clear labeling of circuits. Cable entry points should be smooth, burr-free, and fitted with insulating bushings to prevent short circuits. Each circuit should have individual protection devices such as breakers, fuses, or surge protectors. Grounding and Safety Protection The metal enclosure, electrical installation board, and all metallic components must be reliably grounded. Protective neutral wires should be connected through terminal boards to ensure safety. Follow NEC, IEC, or local codes for grounding, earthing, and short-circuit prot...
