Chilean distribution boxes must comply with Protocol PE N°3/23:2025 for safety certification and follow proper installation practices including placement, wiring, grounding, and protection devices. Regulatory Requirements In Chile, metallic junction or distribution boxes are now subject to mandatory safety certification under Exempt Resolution No. 37.705, which implements Protocol PE N°3/23:2025 . This protocol applies to both surface-mounted and recessed boxes intended for fixed domestic electrical installations and aligns with IEC 60670-1:2024 and IEC 60670-22:2024 standards . Key points include: Boxes must undergo safety testing to ensure compliance with electrical safety standards. Certification must be issued by an accredited Certification Body recognized by the Chilean Electricity and Fuel Board (SEC). Compliance ensures protection against electrical hazards, including short circuits, fire, and mechanical damage . Installation Guidelines Proper installation is critical for safety and long-term reliability : Placement: Install boxes in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters from the floor. Enclosure Selection: Choose boxes with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings for environmental protection. Steel enclosures are preferred for durability, while plastic is suitable for indoor use. Wiring and Grounding: Ensure secure grounding, correct wire gauge, proper insulation, and neat cable management. Each circuit should have its own breaker or fuse. Protection Devices: Include circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors to safeguard each circuit. Testing: Perform visual inspections and multimeter tests before powering on. Labeling and Documentation: Clearly label circuits and maintain records for future inspections. Maintenance: Schedule regular inspections to ensure continued compliance and safety.
