

Installation of Galvanized Cable Tray Clamps

Attachment: Position the clamp over the tray edge or flange, aligning it with the support bracket. Secure using bolts and nuts, preferably truss-head or combination nuts, to maintain stability ().

Edge Protection: If the tray has sharp edges, attach an edge protection strip before clamping to prevent cable damage ().

Connecting Tray Sections Use straight connectors for lengthwise connections and angle connectors for horizontal or vertical turns. For trays wider than 400 mm, include a joint plate to prevent transverse bending (). Insert connectors from the inside of the tray rail and secure with bolts and nuts on the outer side to avoid damaging cables ().

Cable Laying and Securing Lay cables neatly within the tray, maintaining separation by voltage or function. Use cable ties or straps to secure cables to the tray and clamps (). Leave slack for thermal expansion, vibration, or future adjustments.
