

Installing cable trays in infill walls

Cable trays in infill walls must be carefully planned, properly supported, and installed in compliance with NEC standards to ensure safety, load capacity, and accessibility. Planning and Layout Before installation, plan the tray route according to your electrical design and site layout, considering clearance, load capacity, and separation of power and data cables. Selecting Tray Type Choose the appropriate tray type for your application: Ladder trays: Ideal for power cables, allow airflow, and easy cable entry. Perforated trays: Support lighter loads and smaller cables. Solid-bottom or ventilated trough trays: Provide continuous support for control or instrumentation cables. Mounting and Support For infill walls, wall-mounted cantilever brackets are commonly used: Drill holes at marked support points and insert wall anchors suitable for the wall material (e.g., expansion bolts for concrete). Attach cantilever brackets, ensuring they are level and spaced according to manufacturer specifications, typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load. For long runs, use splice plates or couplers to join tray sections securely. Ensure the tray is center-hung or cantilevered to allow easy cable installation and maintain maximum load capacity, which can range from 318 kg to 340 kg per hanger with a maximum support spacing of 3.6 m. Cable Installation Lay cables neatly, using cable ties or straps to separate by voltage and function. Leave slack for expansion or future adjustments. Avoid overfilling; maintain tray fill at 50% or less to prevent overheating and comply with NEC 392.22. Grounding, Bonding, and Firestopping Metallic trays must be grounded and bonded using proper jumpers across sections to maintain electrical continuity. When trays penetrate fire-rated walls, use approved firestop systems to preserve fire-resistance ratings and code co...
