

# Installing cable trays with reverse bends

- 5. Assembly and Installation** Secure the bent tray to supports using clamps or brackets. For wire mesh trays, universal clamps or built-in tabs can be used for quick installation without additional tools. Check alignment and spacing to ensure proper cable routing.

**Tips for Professional Results** Avoid cutting all wires completely in wire mesh trays; partial cuts allow flexibility while maintaining strength. Measure twice before cutting to ensure accurate reverse bend placement. Use protective caps on cut ends to prevent injury and maintain corrosion resistance. For complex bends, practice on a scrap piece of tray to refine technique.
