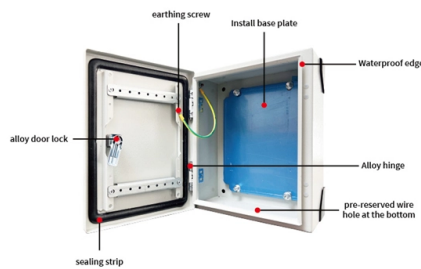


Installing fiber optic cable racks

Use integrated routing guides, trays, and tie-down points to organize cables neatly and separate incoming and outgoing lines. Avoid overcrowding and maintain adequate spacing to reduce stress on connectors and facilitate future adjustments. Use gentle, reusable fasteners like hook-and-loop str...

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Although most fiber optic cables are not conductive, any metallic hardware used in fiber optic cabling systems (such as wall-mounted termination boxes, racks, and patch panels) must be grounded.
