Cable-Specific Strippers: For multi-layer cables, specialized tools like armored cable slitters or buffer tube strippers allow longitudinal or circumferential cuts of outer jackets, aramid yarn, and buffer tubes. Adjustable blades ensure the fiber is not nicked during stripping.

Stripping Procedures

Layer-by-Layer Stripping: Multi-layer cables must be stripped progressively. Start with the outer jacket, then remove aramid yarn, followed by the buffer coating. Each layer requires careful handling to avoid damaging underlying fibers.

Proper Tool Selection: Choose a stripper compatible with the fiber diameter and coating type. For single-fiber cables, hand strippers or heated tools may suffice, while automated systems are preferred...
