

Is it better to use brackets or hangers for cable trays



Overview

Use supports (wall brackets, trapeze hangers, or pedestal supports) at intervals consistent with the tray load rating and manufacturer recommendations. They are ideal when you have limited floor space and need a more out-of-the-way way to support your cable tray. Hanger supports are generally adjustable. These brackets allow the wire mesh tray to sit securely against the wall, preventing it from sagging or shifting over time. It contains the wires in a secure, tidy, and elevated state.
