Italian manufacturers, such as those producing clamps for FIMO® or Fibconet, focus on mechanical reliability, weather resistance, and ease of installation . However, unless the product datasheet explicitly states anti-ESD or anti-electrostatic tracking compliance, it cannot be assumed that the clamp provides this protection.

Recommendations Check product specifications: Look for terms like “ESD-safe,” “anti-static,” or compliance with IEC 61340-5-1 standards.
