Configuration Steps

Install the 200G Line Card: Insert the 200G-capable line card into the optical line terminal chassis. For Cisco NCS 2000 series, ensure the card is compatible with the chassis type (e.g., NCS 2002, NCS 2006, NCS 2015).

Connect Optical Fibers: Use the appropriate MPO or single-fiber connections. For OCI links, ensure Type A/B transceivers are paired correctly to match transmit and receive wavelength groups.

Validate Optical Path: Perform optical validation using built-in OTDR or ORL measurements if supported by the line card (e.g., TNCs-2O card in Cisco NCS 2000 series). This ensures the optical path meets loss and signal quality requirements.

Configure OTN or OCI Parameters: Set up the cross-connect circuit bandwidth (ODU2, ODU2e, ODU4) and slice modes (e.g., OPM_2x40G_2x10G for MXP mode) according to your network design. For OCI, configure the DWDM channel gro...
