AI Overview

A second low-voltage distribution box, often called a sub-main or secondary distribution board, distributes power from the main distribution board to specific zones or equipment, providing protection, monitoring, and flexibility in electrical systems.

Purpose and Function A second LV distribution box, also known as a sub-main distribution board (SMDB), receives power from the main distribution board (MDB) and distributes it to designated areas, circuits, or equipment within a facility. Its primary functions include:

- Circuit protection:** Using MCCBs (Molded Case Circuit Breakers) or ACBs (Air Circuit Breakers) to prevent overloads, short circuits, and electrical faults.
- Load management:** Dividing electrical supply into manageable sections for HVAC systems, lighting, or machinery.
- Monitoring and diagnostics:** Centralizing control for easier maintenance and fault detection.
- Flexibility and expansion:** Allowing future circuit additions without major reconfiguration.

Design and Configuration Secondary LV distribution boxes are typically modular and can be wall-mounted or floor-mounted. They may include:

- Distribution boards for branch circuits.
- Lighting control panels and metering panels.
- Power cabinets with protection against dust, water, and chemical corrosion (IP54 or higher) for harsh environments.
- Communication and BMS integration for monitoring and energy management.

In larger installations, secondary LV boards are often part of secondary unit substations, which combine transformers and LV switchgear close to load centers. This minimizes cable lengths and improves reliability. Configurations may include:

- Simple radial:** One primary incoming circuit feeding the substation.
- Secondary selective:** Two independent buses with a tie breaker, allowing one bus to remain operational if the other fails.
- Loop selective:** Substations fed from two sources in a loop, isolating faults while maintaining service.
- Spot network:** Parallel transformers with network protectors for continuous service even during primary voltage failure.
