Environmental Control Maintaining stable temperature and humidity is critical to prevent micro-bending and signal loss. Recommended conditions are 18–27°C with 40–60% relative humidity. Dust control through air filtration and regular replacement of filters is important, especially in high-density cabling environments. Store cables in dry, cool locations away from chemicals, direct sunlight, or heat sources.

Testing and Monitoring Periodic testing ensures network integrity. Key tests include: Optical Return Loss (ORL) Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) testing Insertion loss measurement using power meters and light sources Polarization Mode Dispersion (PMD) assessment Monitoring live cores and comparing results with commissioning values helps identify potential issues before they cause service disruption.
