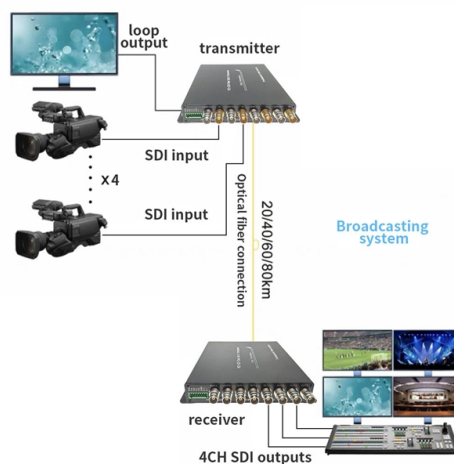

Best suited for small networks, simple deployments, or environments with minimal IT intervention, such as offices, schools, or small campuses. Typically lower cost and easier to deploy but lack advanced control and monitoring features.

Key Considerations

Network Size and Complexity: Managed switches are preferable for medium to large networks with multiple VLANs or high device density. Unmanaged switches are sufficient for small, straightforward networks.

Power Management: Managed PoE switches allow precise control over how much power each port delivers, which is critical for devices with varying power requirements.
