It specifies mechanical performance, load testing, deflection limits, yield strength, and electrical continuity requirements for trays used in grounding or bonding applications. Manufacturers must provide test certificates to demonstrate compliance, ensuring trays can safely support cables over specified spans and environmental conditions. NFPA 70 (NEC) and CEC C22.1-Part 1 provide installation and safety requirements, including ampacity ratings, conductor placement, and methods of installation. These standards ensure that cable trays are not only manufactured correctly but also installed safely in electrical systems. NFPA 79 and NFPA 70E address industrial machinery and employee electrical safety, complementing tray standards by ensuring safe operation and protection from electrical hazards.
