- Spare positions:** Add at least 2 spare slots for troubleshooting or small additions.
- Future growth:** Include 20–25% extra positions to accommodate future expansion. For instance, a setup with 16 circuits plus spares may require a 24- or 30-position box.

Physical and Regulatory Considerations

- NEC compliance:** Panelboards must have a minimum working clearance of 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high in front of the panel, with dedicated space from the floor to 6 feet for safe access.
- Internal volume:** Junction boxes typically range from 1.5 to 3.5 inches in depth, with larger boxes used for complex wiring or larger gauge wires to prevent overcrowding.
- Environmental protection:** IP-rated boxes (e.g., IP65) ensure dust and water resistance for outdoor or harsh environments.
