- 5. Connectors and Fasteners:** Mesh trays often use specialized connectors such as the Magic Connector system or clip-on designs that attach trays to struts or threaded rods without bolts and nuts, simplifying installation.
- 6. Dropouts and Cable Supports:** Side or center dropouts allow cables to exit the tray at specific points. Suspension tubes or trapeze hangers protect cables and maintain balanced loading.
- 7. Accessories for Mounting:** Components include threaded rods, clamps, and suspension kits for ceiling, wall, or floor mounting. These accessories ensure proper alignment, load support, and compliance with safety standards.

Material and Finish Considerations

Mesh trays are available in steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, with finishes tailored to the environment:

- Hot-dip galvanized for outdoor or corrosive environments
- Electro-galvanized for indoor use
