So, you have access to a duct, you have a drum of high-density fiber cable and you're pondering the best way to run the cable through your duct. What are your options?

You may be surprised to learn there are four main methods to achieving your goal. You have pushing, pulling, jetting and blowing. Outdoor cable may be direct buried, pulled or blown into conduit or innerduct, or installed aurally between poles. Indoor cables can be installed in raceways, cable trays above ceilings or under. Fiber optic cable transmits data as light pulses through thin strands of glass or plastic, offering high speed and bandwidth. The hair-thin glass cores within the cable are highly sensitive to physical stress and tight bending, which can cause signal loss or permanent damage.
