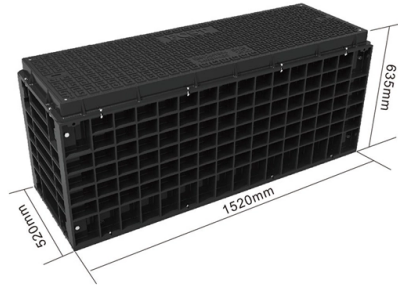


Minimum dimensions for installing a distribution box



Overview

Minimum length = $8 \times$ the trade size of the largest raceway. These requirements prevent conductor damage during installation. Boxes and conduit bodies must remain accessible without removing. Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. This height also safeguards the box from potential. For distribution boxes that handle only lighting circuits or small power loads, if the incoming wire size is less than 10 square millimeters and the number of circuit switches is fewer than 20, the width of the box should be calculated by summing the width of the switches and adding an additional.
