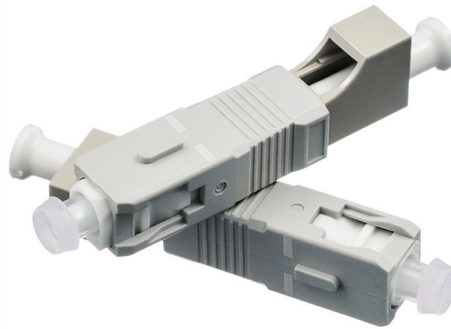

This option is more common in urban and suburban areas but can also serve rural locations where fiber deployment is not feasible. DSL and Cable DSL uses existing telephone lines, while cable internet uses TV coaxial lines. Both are widely available in many regions and can offer speeds sufficient for most home and office needs. DSL typically provides download speeds up to 250 Mbit/s and upload speeds up to 50 Mbit/s, while cable can reach higher speeds, sometimes approaching gigabit levels.
