While OM3 has long been considered the standard for 10-gigabit multimode deployments, OM4 was introduced to support higher bandwidth applications and longer link distances, making it a preferred option in many modern data centers. OM3 fiber and OM4 fiber are both laser-optimized multimode fibers with 50/125µm fiber cores, which need to meet the ISO 11801 standard. However, despite their similar core size and compatibility, these two fiber standards differ in modal bandwidth, maximum.
