Many installers pull fiber by the outer jacket which is prone to. Even though fiber-optic cable is advertised as being more robust than Category 5 unshielded twisted-pair copper cable, pulling it in horizontal cable runs in premises applications requires some special considerations. These considerations are familiar to installers who specialize in optical fiber. Note: Since it is optical fiber, there is no problem with electrical interference. Try new methods like air blowing.
