When you remove the cover plate, it is common to find more than one cable sheath entering the box, which means multiple sets of insulated wires are present. And all the switching and protective devices are installed in the distribution box. Single Phase Distribution Box generally consists of Double Pole MCBs, Single Pole MCBs, and RCCBs.
