

National Standard Steel Fireproof Cable Tray Specifications



AI Overview

Steel fireproof cable trays are designed according to NEMA VE 1, UL 568, and NEC standards, providing rigid, ventilated or solid-bottom support for electrical cables with fire-resistant properties. Material and Construction Steel cable trays are typically fabricated from formed steel side rails welded to rungs for maximum rigidity and strength. Rungs often include Ty-Rap cable tie slots spaced at 1-inch centers for secure cable fastening. The tray bottom may be solid or ventilated, with openings allowing air circulation while supporting cables, and the maximum open spacing between transverse elements does not exceed 102 mm (4 inches) parallel to the side rails. Solid-bottom designs offer enhanced cable protection against fire and mechanical damage.

- UL 568:** Covers performance requirements for fire-resistant fiberglass and steel cable trays, ensuring safe application in fire-prone environments.
- NEC (NFPA 70):** Article 310 and related sections define installation, ampacity, and fire safety requirements for cable trays.
- IEC 61537:** International standard for metal and nonmetal cable trays, including fire performance and mechanical testing.

- Solid-bottom trays to prevent flame penetration.
- Fire-resistant coatings or galvanization to maintain structural integrity under high temperatures.

Compliance with UL 568 fire tests to ensure trays can withstand heat without compromising cable support.
