Speed and Bandwidth Fiber optics can support extremely high data rates, from 1 Gbps to 400 Gbps and beyond, depending on the fiber type and transceivers used. Copper cables are generally limited to 10 Gbps over short distances (Cat6a or Cat7), with performance degrading over longer runs. Fiber is ideal for backbone networks, data centers, and long-distance telecommunications. Distance and Signal Integrity Fiber optic signals can travel tens to hundreds of kilometers without significant loss, especially with single-mode fiber (SMF), while copper Ethernet is limited to 100 meters for standard twisted pair cables. Fiber is also immune to electromagnetic interference (EMI), crosstalk, and ground loops, which can affect copper cables in industrial or high-interference environments. Network Topology and Applications Fiber networks can be deployed in point-to-point or point-to-multipoint topologies, supporting FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home), campus networks, and metropolitan area networks. Copper cables are commonly used for local area networks (LANs) within buildings, connecting computers, switches, and routers over short distances.
