Splicing and Sealing: Splice the optical fibers inside the box and seal it properly to prevent moisture ingress and mechanical stress.

Compliance: Follow local accident prevention regulations and standards such as DIN 48 207, EN 50182, or ANSI/IEEE 524-1980 for safe handling and installation.
