Fixing Method: Use firm and reliable mounting brackets or screws to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration or collision.

Wiring Specifications

Power Off During Wiring: Always turn off the power before wiring to ensure safety.

Wire Selection: Use high-temperature resistant copper core wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load current. Ensure proper insulation and clear wire identification.

Cable Entry and Sealing: All cable inlets and cover joints should be tightly sealed to prevent dust or moisture ingress.

Circuit Protection: Include breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit. Follow the principle of one machine-one switch.
