Mechanical splicing uses alignment sleeves to join fibers without heat. It is faster and less expensive upfront, with per-splice costs generally lower than fusion splicing, often \$15–\$100 per splice depending on project complexity. However, mechanical splices are less durable and more prone to signal loss, making them suitable for temporary or emergency repairs rather than long-term installations.
