

Optical Cable Stacking Method and Price



AI Overview

Optical stacking cables connect multiple switches in a stack, using either active or passive fiber/copper cables, with prices ranging from \$50 to several hundred dollars depending on type and length.

Stacking Methods

- 1. Local Rack Stacking (Dual-Ring Topology)** This method uses short-range stacking cables to connect switches within the same rack or adjacent racks. For example, the AX742 stacking kit allows local dual-ring stacking with rear I/O bays pre-configured for zero-touch stacking, providing up to 48 Gbps per switch (384 Gbps per stack) using 1-meter cables. This method is cost-effective and ideal for high-density deployments.
- 2. Active Optical Cable (AOC) Stacking** Active optical cables convert electrical signals to optical signals, enabling high-speed data transmission over longer distances. Examples include: QSFP AOC 40G to 4x10G, 7 meters: Supports 40G Ethernet with breakout to four 10G lanes, low latency, and EMI resistance, suitable for data center backbone links and switch stacking. QSFP28 AOC 100G, 20 meters: Provides 100G connectivity with plug-and-play installation, ideal for medium-range fiber connections in enterprise networks.
- 3. Passive SFP+ Stacking** Passive copper SFP+ cables, such as the Huawei SFP+STACK-CU1M5 (1.5 m), connect switches without external power or optical transceivers. They are suitable for short-reach stacking within the same rack or adjacent racks, offering low-latency and reliable interconnection while reducing cost and complexity.

Cable Types and Lengths

Cisco FlexStack / StackWise: Available in 50 cm, 1 m, and 3 m lengths, including non-halogen lead-free options.

Huawei SFP+STACK-CU1M5: 1.5 m passive copper cable.

QSFP AOC: 7 m (40G) and 20 m (100G) active optical cables.

Price Range

Short passive copper cables (0.5–1.5 m): Approximately \$50–\$150 per cable depending on brand and remanufactured options.

Active optical cables (7–20 m, 40G–100G): Typically \$200–\$600 or more per cable, depending on length, data rate, and vendor.
