An Optical Terminal Box Interface is the structured point where incoming fiber optic cables are terminated, managed, and connected to distribution or customer-facing fibers, ensuring secure, organized, and maintainable optical connections.

Overview An Optical Terminal Box (OTB), also known as a fiber optic distribution box, fiber access terminal box, or fiber termination box, is a compact enclosure used in FTTH and FTTx networks to manage fiber optic connections between backbone or distribution cables and drop cables leading to end users (). It serves as the interface between the network's optical distribution and the subscriber premises, providing mechanical protection, strain relief, and organized fiber routing.

Key Functions

- Termination and Connection:** The OTB terminates incoming fiber cables and provides standardized adapter ports (commonly SC/APC) for patch cords to connect to ONTs or ONUs ().
- Splicing and Distribution:** It houses fusion splices or mechanical splices, allowing fibers from backbone or distribution cables to be connected to drop fibers or splitters ().
- Splitter Integration:** Some terminal boxes include optical splitters for PON networks, enabling one fiber to serve multiple subscribers ().
- Cable Management:** Provides storage and routing for excess fiber length, ensuring minimal bending and maintaining optical performance ().
- Mechanical Protection:** Protects fibers from physical damage, dust, and moisture, maintaining the optical budget and network reliability ().

Types and Installation

- Indoor vs. Outdoor:** Indoor boxes are typically wall-mounted in corridors, apartments, or IDF rooms, while outdoor boxes can be wall-mounted or pole-mounted ().
- Straight-through vs. Branched:** Straight-through boxes have a single entry for the incoming line, whereas branched boxes have multiple entries for distribution lines ().
- Material and Capacity:** Made from flame-retardant PC, ABS, composite materials, or sheet metal, with capacities ranging from 2 to 24 ports or higher for high-density applications ().
