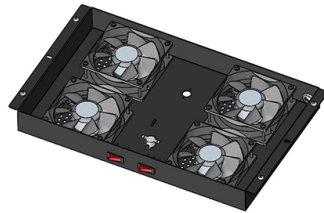

Deployment and Applications Initially, drop cables were deployed in residential FTTH networks, connecting single-family homes or multi-dwelling units (MDUs) to the main fiber network. Over time, their use expanded to enterprise networks, mobile network backhaul, and fiber-to-the-building (FTTB) applications, providing high-bandwidth connectivity for offices, industrial facilities, and cell towers. They can be installed aerially, underground, or indoors, depending on environmental and structural requirements.
