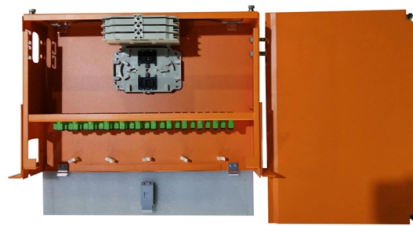

Installation type: Outdoor, underground, aerial, or direct-buried installations may require different conduit configurations for protection against environmental factors. Future expansion: Subdivided conduits allow additional fiber pathways to be added later without installing new conduits.
