Bay spacing has to be carefully evaluated during layout to allow for removal of equipment. In multi-bay configurations, it is common to limit the number of bays to two before increasing the bay center-to-center spacing. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices.
