

PoE Switch After-Sales Process

The after-sales process for PoE switches involves product return, fault verification, repair assessment, and customer communication, with procedures varying based on warranty status and damage type.

Step-by-Step After-Sales Process

- 1. Product Return and Initial Feedback** Customers or channel dealers report defective PoE switches to the manufacturer or branch technical support. The defective product is returned to the company for evaluation, ensuring proper documentation and tracking of the issue.
- 2. Fault Verification** The branch Field Application Engineer (FAE) or technical team determines whether the issue is a hardware fault or a software bug. This step ensures accurate diagnosis before repair or replacement.
- 3. Warranty and Damage Assessment** The accounting or after-sales department verifies the product's warranty status and identifies the type of damage:
 - In-warranty, non-man-made damage: Eligible for free repair.
 - In-warranty, man-made damage or out-of-warranty products: Repair is charged, with a detailed cost list provided to the customer for approval.
- 4. Repair Authorization and Execution** For approved repairs, the maintenance engineer performs the repair analysis and fixes the defective switch. For products not approved for repair, the defective unit is returned to the customer without repair.
- 5. Customer Communication and Payment** The after-sales team communicates repair details, cost estimates, and expected timelines. Payment is collected for charged repairs before the repair process begins.
- 6. Quality Assurance Post-Repair** After repair, the switch undergoes testing to ensure proper functionality, including power delivery, data transmission, and compliance with PoE standards (IEEE 802.3af/at/bt). This ensures the repaired device meets operational and safety standards.
- 7. Documentation and Closure** All repair actions, customer approvals, and warranty adjustments are documented for future reference and service tracking. This ensures transparency and accountability in the after-sales process.
