

PoE Switches and PoE Trunk Switches

PoE Switches A PoE (Power over Ethernet) switch is a network switch that provides both electrical power and data connectivity through a single Ethernet cable to connected devices such as IP cameras, VoIP phones, wireless access points, and IoT devices. PoE Trunk Switches A PoE trunk switch combines the PoE functionality with trunk port capabilities. Trunk ports are designed to carry traffic for multiple VLANs simultaneously, tagging Ethernet frames to indicate VLAN membership while allowing untagged frames to pass across all VLANs. When a PoE switch is configured as a trunk switch:

- It can power devices connected to access ports while simultaneously forwarding VLAN-tagged traffic to other switches.
- This is essential in larger networks where multiple VLANs need to communicate across switches without losing PoE functionality.
- Trunking ensures that devices in different VLANs can receive both data and power efficiently, maintaining network segmentation and performance.
