4. Correct Insertion Procedure Remove dust caps from both ends of the patch cord and the device interface. Insert the connector gently into the optical transceiver or adapter, ensuring proper alignment. Secure the cable using fixing elements or ties to maintain its shape and prevent stress .
5. Disconnecting Safely Before disconnecting, disable the interface or power down the device if possible. Carefully unplug the connector and immediately replace dust caps on both the patch cord and device interface .
6. Storage and Routing Store patch cords in horizontal racks or protective enclosures to avoid bending, crushing, or accidental damage. Never let cords hang freely from equipment or lie loosely on the floor .
