Material costs for multimode fiber typically range from \$0.30 to \$1.00 per foot, with OM1 being the most affordable and OM4 or OM5 costing more due to higher performance standards. Multimode fiber is commonly used in data centers, enterprise LANs, and short-range applications. Pre-terminated assemblies or patch cables increase costs further, depending on connector type and fiber count.

- Fiber Count:** Higher strand counts increase costs proportionally. For example, a 12-strand cable may cost around \$0.50 per foot, while a 24-strand cable can reach \$1.00 per foot.
- Cable Construction:** Indoor riser-rated cables are cheaper than plenum-rated or armored cables suitable for harsh environments or direct burial, which can cost \$0.50–\$5 per foot.
- Material Quality:** Glass fiber cores are standard for high-speed, reliable transmission, while plastic optical fibers are cheap...
