Handholes and vaults: Placement of handholes (30"x48"x36") can be priced per unit, with additional costs for new installations, up-sizing, or site restoration.

Project-Level Costs
Underground installation per mile: Basic projects range from \$5,000 to \$20,000 per mile, while urban areas with complex permitting and traffic control can reach \$60,000–\$80,000 per mile.

Additional factors: Labor rates, permits, conduit condition, and distance from existing infrastructure significantly affect total costs.

Cost Drivers
Fiber count and type: Higher strand counts and multimode fibers increase material costs.

Installation complexity: Confined spaces, traffic control, and long conduit runs raise labor costs.
