Primary Distribution Overview

A primary distribution box is part of the medium-voltage distribution network that carries electricity from substations to distribution transformers near end users. Voltage Transformation Process

Transmission to Primary Distribution: High-voltage electricity from transmission lines (often tens to hundreds of kV) is stepped down at a substation to medium voltage (primary distribution level).

Primary Distribution Box: The primary distribution box distributes this medium voltage along feeders to multiple distribution transformers. It contains equipment such as isolation switches, circuit breakers, and protective devices to manage and protect the network.

Secondary Distribution: Distribution transformers step down the primary voltage to low-voltage secondary circuits, typically 220V single-phase or 380/400V three-phase, which are suitable for residential and commercial use.

Tertiary Distribution: Within buildings, secondary distribution boxes further distribute the 220V supply to individual units or circuits, often including single-phase breakers and protective dev...
